ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

LATIN HOPE COMMUNITY SERVICE OF SOUTH FLORIDA, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) to a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617. Florida Statutes, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the corporation shall be: LATIN HOPE COMMUNITY SERVICE OF SOUTH FLORIDA, INC.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSE OF CORPORATION

Latin Hope Community Service of South Florida, Inc., is organized and operated exclusively for prevention testing, mental health services, scientific, education, and community health services. Provide quality information, education, prevention, program services, and health care regarding HIV/AIDS related services and to provide referrals to and for persons infected and/or affected by HIV/AIDS.

ARTICLE III

DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Second hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a Corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
