(a Florida Not for Profit Corporation)

Pursuant to Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, the undersigned, as the sole incorporator of FAMILIES of TRAUMA RESOURCE NETWORK, INC., hereby makes, subscribes and files these Articles of Incorporation of FAMILIES of TRAUMA RESOURCE NETWORK, INC. ("Corporation"), a not for profit corporation, as follows:

ARTICLE I

CORPORATE NAME

The name of this Corporation is FAMILIES of TRAUMA RESOURCE NETWORK, INC.

ARTICLE II

CORPORATE PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for one or more of the purposes described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the specific purpose for which this Corporation is organized and shall be operated is to provide support services, education, counseling and other resources and services to the families and victims of acute trauma crises.

ARTICLE III

PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The street and mailing address of the initial principal office of the Corporation is 14616 Greenover Lane, Jacksonville, Florida 32258.

ARTICLE IV

REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is 14616 Greenover Lane, Jacksonville, Florida 32258 and the registered agent of the Corporation at that address is Norma

Youmans.

ARTICLE V

DURATION

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence. The Corporation's existence shall commence with the filing of these Articles of Incorporation by the Florida Department of State.

ARTICLE VI

INCORPORATORS

The name and address of the incorporator of the Corporation is as follows:

ARTICLE VII

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The business and the affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors consisting of not less than three (3) Directors. The method of election of Directors to the Board of Directors, the terms of office of Directors elected to the Board of Directors, the method by which vacancies on he Board of Directors shall be filled, and the term of office of each such member of the Board of Directors shall be as specified in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VIII

EARNINGS AND ACTIVITIES OF CORPORATION

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a Corporation exempt from

Federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 of the United States Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or the corresponding provisions of any future United State Internal Revenue Law).

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, this Corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this Corporation.

ARTICLE IX

DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all the assets of the Corporation exclusively to (a) such organization or organizations, organized and operated exclusively for one or more of the purpose specified under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and shall ave at that time qualified as an exempt organization or organizations un Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), or (b) the federal government or to a sate or local government for a public purpose, as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any assets of the Corporation not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively to (a) such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for one or more of the purposes specified under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and which shall have at that time qualified as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), or (b) to the federal government or to state or local government for a public purpose.

ARTICLE X

DEDICATION OF ASSETS

The property of this Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to one or more of the purposes described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended, and no part of the net income or assets of this Corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any private individual.
