Articles of Incorporation

Of

Power From On High Christian Center, Inc. A Florida Non-Profit Corporation



Article of incorporation of the undersigned, desiring to form a non-profit Ministry corporation Under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of chapter 617, Florida Statutes, do hereby certify:

ARTICLE 1. NAME

The name of the Corporation is Power From On High Christian Center, Inc.

ARTICLE 2. DURATION

The Duration of the Corporation is Perpetual.

ARTICLE 3. PLACE OF BUSINESS

The principal office of the Corporation is 900 NW 7th Avenue, Miami, Florida 33136 The mailing address of the Corporation is 19833 SW 103rd Court, Miami, Florida 33157

ARTICLE 4. PURPOSE (S)

The purpose(s) for which Power From On High Christian Center, Inc., is formed are exclusively religious, charitable, and educational within the means of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, and consist of the following:

Section 1.

Religious Services - Sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ through the body of Christians, Prayer, Teaching, Preaching, and Gospel music for individual salvation.

Section 2.

Charitable - Engaging in activities to aid the poor, the distressed, and the under privilege, working with various charities located in the Greater Miami area.

Section 3.

Educational – Academic incentive program designed to reward students who do well in school. Grades are tracked each quarter and rewards are given based upon progress in quarterly reports. Progress must be noted in academics, volunteerism and attitude/behavior. Rewards consist of gift certificates to clothing stores, restaurants, and recreational centers. Rewards also include trophies and financial scholarships.

Section 4.

Publication - To provide a publication ministry spreading the good news, through disseminating religious written messages ministering to all humanity.

Section 5.

Community Service Employment program. Promote self-sufficiency among young adults (18-23). The program will provides employers with short-term subsidy for work-experience, and helps upgrade entry-level workers skills toward readiness for employment. The goal is to provide young adults with the training they need to become employable, and connect them with businesses that are looking for motivated, well train employees.

Section 6.

Power From On High Christian Center, Inc. is to engage in any and all lawful business purpose(s) in the United State of America upon non-profit corporations. It is not for a private gain. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered. To make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this article. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not. Participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Not withstanding any part of these articles.

Section 7.

This Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to carry on. (a) By a Corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal income tax code. (b.) By a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(C)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future tax code.

ARTICLE 5. CORPORATION DISSOLUTION

The Corporation Distribution of Assets, upon the dissolution or winding up of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment or provision for payment of all debts and liabilities of the corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation. Which is organized and operated exclusively for religious, and charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.

ARTICLE 6. MEMBERS

The Corporation shall have voting members, who shall be elected (and may be removed) by the voting members, and who shall have all the rights and privileges of members of the Corporation. The bylaws may provide for non-voting members of one or more classes, who shall be admitted in such manner and who shall have such rights and privileges as are set forth in the bylaws, but who shall not have the right to vote.
