Articles of Incorporation
of
Helps International, Incorporated

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SECRETARY OF STATE
TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

The undersigned, acting as the incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

Article 1

The name of the corporation is HELPS INTERNATIONAL, INCORPORATED.

Article 2

The principle place of business and the mailing address of this corporation is 8730 Chisholm Road, Pensacola, Florida 32514, Escambia County.

Article 3

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law), including, but not limited to, for such purposes, the establishing of a computer training center for missionaries and the local community, the providing of free or low-cost computers to those in need; and any other lawful purpose or purposes not for pecuniary profit and not specifically prohibited to non-profit corporations under the laws of the state of Florida or to tax -exempt organizations under the Internal Revenue Code.

Article 4

The method of election of directors shall be stated in the Bylaws of the corporation. The corporation shall have a minimum of three (3) directors.

Article 5

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the tax-exempt purposes of the corporation set forth in Article 3.

Article 6

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the

corporation to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, religious, or educational purposes as shall at the time qualify as an organization exempt from Federal income taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine.

Article 7

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Article 8

The Corporation shall have a racially nondiscriminatory policy and shall not discriminate against employees, applicants, students, and others on the basis of race, color, or national or ethnic origin. The Corporation shall admit students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students and shall be racially nondiscriminatory in the administration of all of its policies and programs.

Article 9

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 8730 Chisholm Road, Pensacola, Florida 32514, and the name of the initial registered agent of the corporation at the initial registered office is David Sargent.

Article 10

The name of the incorporator of the corporation is David Sargent and the address of the incorporator is 8730 Chisholm Road, Pensacola, Florida 32514.

Article 11

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, except that the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

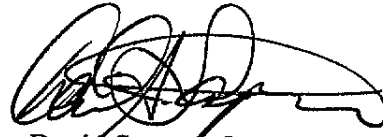
Article 12

The corporation shall not discriminate against directors, officers, employees, trainees, or others on the basis of race, color, or national or ethnic origin. The corporation will admit trainees of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available made to trainees at any educational activity of the corporation. The corporation shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in the administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, scholarship and loan programs, and athletic and any other program administered by the corporation.

Article 13

The period of the duration of the corporation is perpetual unless dissolved according to law.
