ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION



TASECATION S. PM 2:50 LANDMARK MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH OF MASCOTTE, INC. a Not for Profit Corporation

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE !

The corporation shall be a corporation not for profit pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and its name shall be:

LANDMARK MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH OF MASCOTTE, INC., and said name shall be so registered with the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations.

ARTICLE II

The corporation shall have perpetual existence until dissolved by the laws of the State of Florida, said perpetual existence to commence upon the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations.

ARTICLE III

The principal place of business of the corporation shall be located at 210 East Mohawk, Mascotte, Lake County, Florida, or at such other place as may from time to time be specified by the Board of Directors (the Board).

The corporation shall maintain a mailing address of Post Office Box 593, Groveland, Florida 34736.

ARTICLE IV

The Corporation is a not for profit corporation. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

The corporation is formed to operate exclusively for charitable a. purposes which will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, including, for those purposes, the making of distributions to organizations which qualify as tax exempt organizations under that code.

- b. The specific purpose for which the corporation is organized is to teach and practice the following Bible doctrines:
- The Bible is the infallible, inspired Work of God (II Timothy 3:16-17).
 - 2, The Triune God (Matthew 28:19).
 - The Genesis Account of Creation.
 - The Virgin Birth of Jesus Christ (Matthew 1:20).
 - 5. The Deity of Jesus Christ (John 1:1, 10:30).
 - The vicarious sacrifice of Jesus Christ (Hebrews 2:9).
- 7. Salvation is by grace through faith in Christ...not of works (Ephesians 2:8-9) before and without water baptism.
- 8. The eternal security of believers ("once saved, always saved"); i.e., all believers are preserved eternally (I Peter 1:5, John 10:27-30).
- 9. The bodily resurrection and ascension of Jesus, and the bodily resurrection of His saints (I Corinthians 15).
- 10. The Second Coming of Jesus Christ, personal and bodily, as the crowning event of this Gentile age (Acts 1:11).
- 11. Christ will set up His kingdom on earth and rule upon the earth 1,000 years (Revelations 20:6).
- 12. The eternal punishment of the finally impenitent in hell (Matthew 25:46).
- 13. The church of our Lord was established by Jesus during His personal ministry on earth, before the day of Pentecost, and has an unbroken history to this present day.
- 14. A Scriptural church is a local, visible assembly of Scripturally baptized believers, covenanted together under New Testament law for the purpose of carrying out the Great Commission (Matthew 28: 18-20).
- 15. Scriptural baptism is immersion of believers, administered by a New Testament Church.
- 16. The Lord's Supper is a memorial ordinance, restricted to faithful church members of the local assembly only.

c. This corporation shall not, as a substantial part of its activities, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate or intervene, by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise, in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

The members of this corporation shall be the subscribers hereto and those persons who are and will be members of the congregation of the LANDMARK MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH OF MASCOTTE, INC.

ARTICLE V

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by members of the corporation, who shall be no less than three (3) in number.

The procedure for election of the officers and directors of the corporation, shall be as set forth in the bylaws of the corporation as from time to time amended.

ARTICLE VI

The corporation shall have all the powers set forth in Chapter 617, the Florida Not for Profit Corporation act, as in effect from time to time including, but not limited to the following powers:

- a. Have succession by its corporate name for the period set forth in its Articles of Incorporation.
- b. Sue and be sued and appear and defend in all actions and proceedings in its corporate name to the same extent as a natural person.
- c. Adopt, use, and alter a common corporate seal. However, such seal must always contain the words "corporation not for profit."
- d. Elect or appoint such officers and agents as its affairs shall require and allow them reasonable compensation.
- e. Adopt, change, amend, and repeal bylaws, not inconsistent with law or its articles of incorporation, for the administration of the affairs of the corporation and the exercise of its corporate powers.
- f. Increase, by a vote of its members cast as the bylaws may direct, the number of its directors so that the number shall not be than five but may be any number in excess thereof.

- g. Make contracts and incur liabilities, borrow money at such rates of interest as the corporation may determine, issue its notes, bonds, and other obligations and secure any of its obligations by mortgage and pledge of all or any of its property, franchises, or income.
- h. Conduct its affairs, carry on its operations, and have officers and exercise the powers granted by this act in any state, territory, district or possession of the United States or any Foreign country.
- i. Purchase, take, receive, lease, take by gift, devise, or bequest, or otherwise acquire own, hold, improve, use, or otherwise deal in and with real or personal property, or any interest therein, wherever situated.
- j. Acquire, enjoy, utilize and dispose of patents, copyrights, and trademarks and any other rights or interests thereunder or therein.
- k. Sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, lease, exchange, transfer, or otherwise dispose of all or any part or its property and assets.
- I. Purchase, take, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, use, employ, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge, or otherwise dispose of and otherwise use and deal in and with, shares and other interests in, or obligations of, other domestic or foreign corporations, whether for profit or not for profit, associations, partnerships, or individuals, or direct or indirect obligations of the United States or of any government, state, territory, government district, municipality, or of any instrumentality thereof.
- m. Lend money for its corporate purposes, invest and reinvest its funds, take and hold real and personal property was security for payment of funds loaned or invested except as prohibited by Section 617.0833, Florida Statutes.
- n. Make donations for the public welfare or religious, charitable, scientific, educational, or other similar purposes.
- o. Have and exercise all powers necessary or convenient to effect any or all of the purposes for which the corporation is organized.
- p. Merge with other corporations both for profit and not for profit,
 domestic and foreign, if the surviving corporation is a corporation not for profit.

ARTICLE VII

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member, or to the benefit of any private individual.

ARTICLE VIII

On the dissolution or winding up of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of the corporation, shall be distributed to a not for profit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.

ARTICLE IX

Unless otherwise set forth herein, the corporation reserves the right, in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida governing corporations, to amend, alter, modify, or repeal any provision or provisions contained in these articles of incorporation, or any amendment thereto, and any rights conferred upon members is subject to this reservations.

ARTICLE X

Subject to change from time to time by the Board, the street address of the Registered Office of this Corporation is 12609 Gopherbroke Road, Groveland, Florida, 34736, and DEBBIE PATTERSON, shall be the initial Registered Agent of the Corporation at this address.

ARTICLE XI
