ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

CHRISTIAN LIFE MINISTRIES INTERNATIONAL, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:



ARTICLE III PURPOSE(S) OF CORPORATION

The specific purpose (s) for which the corporation is organized is (are):

The corporation is organized pursuant to the provisions of the general non-profit corporation law of the State of Florida.

The corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and including, to the extent permitted by said Section 501 (c)(3), the following:

A. To preach the gospel of Jesus Christ, both nationally and internationally, for the purpose or benefit of bringing men and women into the knowledge of salvation; healing lives through physical, emotional, spiritual, and financial counseling; proclaiming liberty to those held in various types of captivity; building a strong community church relationship through various outreach programs.

- B. To reach the total man, woman, boy, girl, and family by hosting seminars and conferences annually to educate the community in areas that are spiritual, historical, cultural, social, economical, political, and areas that pertain to eternal preparation. To provide these services to everyone through tape, radio or television.
- C. To bring the church and the community together by hosting outreach programs, i.e. elderly care, youth recreational activities, nutrition and health counseling and services, economic and financial counseling and services, home ownership counseling, life application skills, girls and boys club.
- D. To establish a program for the elderly that will provide overall care, which includes transportation to and from doctor's appointment, pharmacy, grocery stores; seniors day out to provide recreational activities; computer classes and other educational classes.
- E. To establish a boys and girls club which will include after school programs and activities, tutorial programs, recreational activities, educational outreach program combined with music that is geared towards youth that may not be reachable through regular church attendance. These services or programs will include academic education through reading music, music festivals, and seminars. These programs will also include teen counseling, pregnancy prevention & counseling, youth forums, juvenile crime awareness & prevention, drug awareness & prevention.
- F. To provide housing opportunities which will include how to purchase and sell real estate that will include sharing resources, and purchasing property for specific individuals.
- G. To institute economic and financial counseling and support, which will provide goods and services to the community and job opportunities. Small stores, various kinds of shops, Christian bookstore and gift shop.
- H. To provide in-depth information and counseling on good nutrition and health, i.e. written and oral instructions in classes, exercise classes and walking club.
- I. To exercise all rights and powers conferred on not for profit corporations under the laws of the State of Florida, provided, however, that the corporation shall not engage in any activities or exercise any powers, that are not in furtherance of the specific and primary religious, charitable, and educational purposes of the corporation. All of the foregoing purposes and powers shall be exercised exclusively for the religious, charitable, and educational purposes shall be exercised in such manner that the corporation shall qualify as an exempt organization under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 as it is currently or hereafter may be in force and effect.
- J. The corporation shall not devote more than an insubstantial part of its activities to the caring on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, directly or indirectly, any political campaign on behalf of or, in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

 Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal and state income taxes under section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and Florida Statues Chapter 617 as the same may be amended from time to time. The

- corporation shall not have objectives or engage in activities that characterize it as an "action" organization as defined in Treasury Regulation 1.501 (C) (3).
- K. The Corporation is and shall remain a corporation not for profit. The corporation shall not have nor issue shares of stock. The corporation is not organized, nor shall it be operated for the primary purpose of generating pecuniary gain or profit, and it will not distribute any gains, profits, or dividends to the members thereof, or to any individual, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in the furtherance of it's specific and primary purposes. The property, assets, profits, and net income of the corporation are irrevocably dedicated to religious, charitable, and educational purposes, and no part of the profit or net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit or any director, officer, or member thereof or to the benefit of any individual or any private shareholder.

ARTICLE VII LIMITATION OF CORPORATE POWERS

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in Section 617.302, Florida Statues, unless limited as follows:

INCONSISTENT ACTIVITIES: This corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in activities or exercise any powers that are in themselves not in furtherance of the specific and primary purposes of this corporation as set forth in Article III.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, this Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income tax under Section 501 (C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding tax code, or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(C)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any further federal tax code.

DISCRIMINATION: All activities and staff positions of any sort will be on a racially nondiscriminatory basis. There shall be no discrimination against applicants for any staff positions and those who wish to attend church services and/or desire to be a member of the Corporation (Church).

SALARIES: Any salaries, wages, together with fringe benefits or other forms of compensation (housing, transportation, and other allowances) paid to or provided to any employee, director, or officer will not exceed a value which is reasonable and commensurate with the duties and work hours associated with such employment and with the compensation ordinarily paid persons with similar positions and duties.

NET INCOME: No part of the net earnings (income surplus) of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, directors, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Three.

ARTICLE VIII DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

No persons, firms, or corporation shall ever receive any dividends or profits from the undertaking of the corporation. In the event of dissolution of the corporation, the residual assets of the corporation remaining after payment of, or provisions for payment of, all debts and liabilities of the corporation, shall be distributed to one or more organizations, which themselves are exempt as organizations described in section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, exclusively to accomplish public purposes and none of the assets will be distributed to any member, director, officer, or trustee of this corporation.
