Articles of Incorporation of A Florida Nonprofit Corporation

Article 1. Name and Address

The name of corporation is: Abundant Grace Christian Center Inc. 3760 South University Blvd Apt. # 1007, Jacksonville, Fl 32216.

Article 2. Duration

The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

Article 3. Purposes

The purpose of the corporation is as follows:

- (A) This corporation is a not-for-profit corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes. It is not organized for the private gain of any person. The specific purposes of this corporation are: the purpose and general nature of this corporation as an organization of Christians shall be the maintenance, promotion, teaching, and general furthering of the Church, and the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and the advancing of His Kingdom throughout the world as set forth in that portion of Holy Writ known as the New Testament, and more particularly to own and maintain facilities for public worship and to provide for worship and religious instruction and other Christian activities.
- (B) To exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon nonprofit corporations.
- (C) Provided, however, that the corporation shall not engage in any action which is not permitted to be carried on by nonprofit corporations under the Internal Revenue Code; and no part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to its members, director, or officers; but the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation to these people for service rendered, and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its stated purposes.

Article 4. Members

The corporation shall have voting members, who shall be elected (and may be removed) by the voting members, and who shall have all the rights and privileges of members of the corporation. The bylaws may provide for non-voting members of one or more classes, who shall be admitted in such manner and who shall have such rights and privileges as set forth in the bylaws, but who
