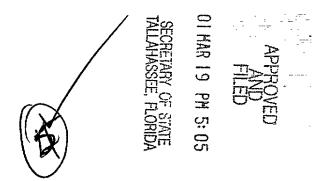

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

(NOT FOR PROFIT)

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: IGLESIA CRISTIANA ENSEÑANZA JESUS INC.

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be: 189 Toluca Dr. Kissimmee Florida, 34743.

ARTICLE III **PURPOSES**

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized is: to create a Christian Church, (a nonprofit organization), with a Biblical School department and with missionary, literature, educational, and other departments it may deem useful to propagate and practice the full Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ and for its service to the community, and pursuant thereto to license and ordain Christian Workers and Ministers and Missionaries and to plan and establish Branches and indigenous churches.

ARTICLE VIII

MEMBERS

All persons who give evidence to their faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and who voluntarily subscribe to the tenets of faith and agree to be governed by the By-laws of this

corporation, and who further agree to answer all questions on the membership application shall be considered members in IGLESIA CRISTIANA ENSEÑANZAS DE JESUS INC.

ARTICLE IX LIMITATIONS

The assets and income of this corporation shall be used for religious, charitable or educational purposes. Such use shall be at the approval and direction of the Directors.

No part of the assets or income of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions on furtherance of the purposes set forth hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public offices.

Not withstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501. (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the Corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

ARTICLE X BY-LAWS

The By-laws of this corporation shall be made, altered or rescinded by a majority vote of the Directors of this Corporation present at any meeting of the Board of Directors provided written notice of the proposed By-laws or amendments shall be given the Directors at least one week prior to the date of such meeting.
