In reference to corporation formation filing document number: N01000001965

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1007, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation submits the following restatement of one of its articles of incorporation.

Restatement of Article III:

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes related to promoting the prevention and reduction of substance abuse and to reducing the risk factors associated with substance abuse and related problem behaviors.

The corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

This restatement of Article III specifies more clearly the organization's purpose and limitations on purpose as approved in actions unanimously taken by Coalition members on February 8, 2001, and, through their prior approval, as agreed to by all Board members upon election to their positions on April 5, 2001.
