ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

VOLUNTEER ASSISTANCE FOR INDEPENDENT LIVING, INC.

(A Florida Not For Profit Corporation)

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a Corporation under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

VOLUNTEER ASSISTANCE FOR INDEPENDENT LIVING, INC.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of the corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

A. The general nature and object of the Corporation shall be primarily to coordinate services for, and to provide services to, persons with disabilities; to assist them in obtaining and retaining an independent lifestyle; to assist them in their daily life skill tasks; and such other purposes and activities as would be appropriate to accomplish the basic objects of the Corporation.

B. The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and

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educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

C. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.



The balance of all money and other property received by the Corporation from any source after the payment of all debts and obligations of the Corporation shall be used or distributed to other organizations which support the performing arts and which themselves are exempt organizations described in Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal Government, or to a state or local government for public purpose.




