The undersigned, hereby makes, subscribes, acknowledges and files the following Articles for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME AND ADDRESS

The name of this corporation is HISPANIC AMERICAN HELPING HANDS, INC. The mailing address is: 1650 Neptune Rd., Kissimmee, FL 34744.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSES
