I, the undersigned, desiring to associate for the purpose of forming a song and dance corporation geared toward education and ministry, not for profit under the laws of the State of Florida, pursuant to the provision of Chapter 617 of the Statutes of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, liabilities, rights, privileges and immunities of a corporation not for profit, do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I

NAME OF CORPORATION
