ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF:

CIRCUIT AGAINST PRISON ESCAPEES, INC.

(A Florida Non-Profit Corporation)

The undersigned incorporators of Circuit Against Prison Escapees, Inc., hereby associated themselves together as a corporation not for profit under the following Articles of Incorporation, to wit:

ARTICLE I. NAME AND LOCATION

The name of this corporation, not for profit, shall be CIRCUIT AGAINST PRISON ESCAPEES, INC., located at 11273 Lisa Drive, Glen St. Mary, Florida 32040, whose mailing address is P.O. Box 81, Glen St. Mary, Florida 32040.

ARTICLE II. CORPORATE NATURE

This is a non-profit corporation, organized solely for cooperative purposes pursuant to the Florida Corporations Not for Profit law set forth in Section 617 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE III. DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence and shall commence to exist as of the filing

date of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE IV. GENERAL AND SPECIFIC PURPOSES

This corporation is organized for the purpose of providing a free web site and television advertisements to the general public that features Federal and State prison escapees in the United States. This service will be a safety measure for the general public and a confidential avenue to check out suspicious individuals. This service will provide a national "mug shot" gallery without the need of a name, Department of Corrections number, or state of escape.

ARTICLE V. CORPORATE OFFICERS AND MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

There are two officers of the Corporation. Their names and addresses are as follows; FRANZ P. BUCKREM, PRESIDENT, #049061, P.O. Box 221-E2-102, Raiford, Florida 32083, DIANNA M. BUCKREM, VICE PRESIDENT, 11273 Lisa Drive, Glen St. Mary, Florida 32040. The name and address of the initial registered agent and office of this corporation is DIANNA M. BUCKREM, 11273 Lisa Drive, Glen St. Mary, Florida 32040.

ARTICLE VI. INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

This corporation shall have three directors initially and are appointed. The number of directors may be either increased or decreased from time to time by an amendment of the bylaws of the corporation in the manner provided by law, but shall never be less than three. The name and address of the initial directors of this corporation are; **FRANZ P. BUCKREM**, #049061, P.O. Box

221-E2-102, Raiford, Florida 32083, **DIANNA M. BUCKREM**, 11273 Lisa Drive, Glen St. Mary, Florida 32040, and **MABLE MARSHALL**,7956 Johns Drive, Sneads, Florida 32460.

ARTICLE VII. EARNINGS AND ACTIVITIES OF CORPORATION

- A) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV hereof.
- B) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE VIII. DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the assets of the corporation in such manner to the American Cancer Society, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of

competent jurisdiction in the county in which principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes, to such organization or organizations as such Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IX. MEMBERSHIP

Membership is open to the general public and shall not be restricted in any way by reason of race, creed, gender, or nationality.

ARTICLE X. AMENDMENT OF BY-LAWS

The By-laws may, from time to time, be amended, subject to the limitations contained in the By-laws, and any limitations set forth in the Corporation Not for Profit law of the State of Florida, concerning corporate action that must be adopted, either by a resolution of the Board of Directors, or by following the procedure set forth in the By-laws.

ARTICLE XI. DEDICATION OF ASSETS

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to cooperative purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private individual other than as it benefits the entire Circuit Against Prison Escapees, Inc.

ARTICLE XII. AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES

Amendment to these Articles of Incorporation may be proposed by a resolution adopted by the Board of Directors and presented to a quorum of members for their vote.
