ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of the CAPITAL JUSTICE AND RESTORATION INITIATIVE, INC.

<u>Articles of Incorporation of the Capital Justice and Restoration Initiative, Inc.</u>, who are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation shall be Capital Justice and Restoration Initiative, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The initial place in Florida where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located is 1215 NW 4th Street, Gainesville, Florida 32601. The Board may choose to relocate the principal office to another site within the State of Florida at its discretion.

ARTICLE III

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes and is not organized for the private gain of any person. The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized are to work to guarantee equal protection and due process under the law to persons who are capitally charged and/or condemned; to provide support services to persons capitally charged and/or condemned and to their families; to provide representation to persons capitally charged and/or condemned; to provide support services to victims of capital crimes and to their families; to educate and provide resources to attorneys, investigators and other professionals in their representation of capitally charged and/or condemned persons; and to provide information to students, members of the public and community organizations about the criminal justice system and capital punishment.

ARTICLE IV

The business affairs of Capital Justice and Restoration Initiative, Inc. shall be managed by its Board of Directors, which may exercise all corporate powers not specifically prohibited by statute, by the certificate of incorporation, or by the bylaws, and which is directed in all ways to maintain the qualification of the corporation under Sec. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code as an exempt charitable organization. The Directors are Elected as States in the bylaws.
