**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
HEALTH EDUCATION ADVOCATORS RESOURCE TEAM, INC.
("HEART")**

(A Corporation Not for Profit under
the Laws of the State of Florida)

We, the undersigned, pursuant to Section 617.0202, Florida Statutes, subscribed to these Articles of Incorporation, natural people competent to Contract, do hereby form a corporation Not for Profit under the laws of the state of Florida.

**ARTICLE I
NAME**

The name of the Corporation is HEALTH EDUCATION ADVOCATORS RESOURCE TEAM, INC. ("HEART").

**ARTICLE II
PRINCIPLE PLACE OF BUSINESS**

The principal office of HEALTH EDUCATION ADVOCATORS RESOURCE TEAM, INC. ("HEART") shall be at 141 NW Second Street, Belle Glade, FL 33430. The Board of Directors may from time to time designate such other address and place for its principal office of this Corporation as it may see fit.

**ARTICLE III
PURPOSE**

The corporation will make no distributions of Income to its Directors, unless it is dissolved pursuant to Florida law. The specific purposes for which this Corporation is formed include, but are not limited to, the following:

3.1 HEALTH EDUCATION ADVOCATORS RESOURCE TEAM, INC. ("HEART") has a special commitment to build collaborative partnerships by sharing information, solving problems and participating in community initiatives to promote experiential learning.

3.2 To reduce high risk behaviors in children and youth, especially, but not limited to those youth living in African American, Haitian and Latino communities.

3.3 To develop, deliver and otherwise make available a Peer Education Training curriculum.

3.4 To provide information to target groups that address health and safety issues through Community Activities and Training.

3.5 To provide training and certification program for adolescents as Peer Counselors on wellness issues.

3.6 To serve as a model and trainer for other communities interested in delivering prevention and risk reduction messages through a Peer Education program that has demonstrated success.

3.7 To exercise all powers and discharge all responsibilities granted to it as a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, its By-Laws, and these Articles of Incorporation.

3.8 To otherwise engage in any lawful activities for the benefit, use, convenience, and enjoyment of its students as it may deem proper.

ARTICLE IV DIRECTORS

Section 4.1 Number and Qualification. The property business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board consisting of not less than three (3) Directors. Other provisions regarding qualifications of Directors are contained in the By-Laws.

Section 4.2 Duties and Powers. All of the duties and powers of the Corporation existing under Florida Statutes, these Articles and the By-Laws shall be exercised exclusively by the Board of Directors, when such approval is specifically required, in the Declaration, these Articles or the By-Laws.

Section 4.3 Election; Removal. Directors of the Corporation shall be elected at the Annual Meeting in the manner determined by and subject to the qualifications set forth in the By-Laws. Directors may be removed and vacancies on the Board of Directors shall be filled in the manner provided by the By-Laws.

Section 4.4 Initial Directors (In Office as of the date of filing these Articles). The name and address of the first Board of Directors who, subject to the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation, the Bylaws of this Corporation, and the laws of Florida, shall hold office until his successors is chosen at the First Annual Meeting of this Corporation to be held at the time and place provided for by the Bylaws, is as follows:




