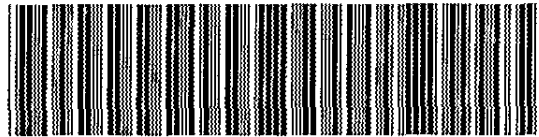

**CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT  
TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF  
EASTSIDE HISTORICAL COMMUNITY FOUNDATION, INC.**

1. The undersigned directors certify that they constitute a majority of the Board of Directors of the aforementioned Corporation, formed pursuant to the provisions of the laws of the State of Florida, that said Corporation have adopted the following amendments to the Articles of Incorporation of said Corporation.

Article III, Purpose shall be amended as follows

The nature of the business or purposes to be conducted or promoted is organized and operated exclusively to provide programs, services training and support to the community and other economically disadvantaged groups who are unable to independently survive and need human services and assistance. And to engage in any lawful act or activities that are charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, and pursuant to the not-for-profit code for which corporations may be organized under the General Corporation Law of the state of Florida.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this organization shall not have a membership and shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, director, officer of the organization, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the organization), and no member, trustee, officer of the organization or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the organization's assets on dissolution of the organization.

No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by IRC 501 (h) or participating in, or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidates for public office.

In the event of dissolution, all of the remaining assets and property of the organization shall after payment of necessary expenses thereof be distributed to such organizations as shall qualify under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal Tax Laws, or to the Federal government of State or local government for a public purpose, subject to the approval of Justice of the Supreme Court of the State of Florida.


The organization will, insure that Section 1.501 (c) (3)-1(d)(1)(ii) of the Income Tax Regulations which states that an organization must serve public interest to qualify for tax exempt status, will be complied with in all interests and activities.




