

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Signature/Incorporator

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is the transaction of any of all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Florida Corporation Act. The primary purposes are as follows:

- (1) to assist with promoting educational, training and employment preparation and placement programs, job training, health education and structured self sufficiency programs to primarily benefit low and moderate income families residing in and around the Northeast Florida region.
- (2) to develop economic development and empowerment programs to meet other community needs having a particular urgency because existing conditions pose a continuous problem of serious and immediate threat to the economic welfare of the community and
- (3) to provide programs to fund special social and human services where other financial resources are not available to meet such needs through self help programs; to expand the scope of programs and activities of public and private agencies, and institutions; to equalize minorities and disadvantaged individuals who heretofore have not received a fair opportunity to share in the riches of this country, the United States; to provide outreach and to encourage the active participation of minorities and disadvantaged communities in establishing self help projects and programs; to provide greater interaction and cooperation between organizations designed to assist minorities and hapless communities in the areas of crime prevention, recreation, physical planning, technical assistance to the elderly and dependent; to provide financial and technical assistance to the underserved population within the surrounding catchment area and actively participate in regionwide programs which seek to develop greater business and economic opportunities for minorities and the disadvantaged.
