Article I - Name

The name of the Corporation is CSS Tennessee / USS Hartford, Inc.

Article II - Dutation

This corporation shall have perpetual existence commencing on the date of execution and acknowledgment of these Articles or until such time as it shall be dissolved by law.

<u> Article III – Purpose</u>

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, more specifically to The CSS Tennessee/USS Hartford is committed to authenticity, professionalism & bringing to life the Naval activities and Naval life during the Civil War, and enlightening the public of Naval History and Historic Preservation.
