ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION to the Articles of In Compliance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes (Not for Profit) INCORPORATION

## ARTICLE I

#### NAME

The name of the corporation shall be The Frank and Yvonne Kyle Education Foundation, Incorporated.

#### ARTICLE II

## PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

#### ARTICLE III

#### **PURPOSE**

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to assist individuals in their pursuit of educational opportunities. The Frank and Yvonne Kyle Education Foundation, Inc., is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Nothwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an

organization, contributions to which are deductible under 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state of local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

#### ARTICLE IV

#### MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the directors are appointed is by simple majority. An appointment to the corporation is limited to family members of Frank and Yvonne Kyle through birth or marriage. Appointments will be made as vacancies arise. Any director may nominate a candidate for appointment. Simple majority must approve nominees. There shall be no more than nine members at any one time. Appointments to the board of directors are valid for five years. Any director may be re-appointed for unlimited successive terms.
