ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FOR

GOODWILL ACADEMY, INC.

The undersigned incorporators, being competent to contract, subscribe to these Articles of Incorporation to form a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: Goodwill Academy, Inc.

ARTICLE II – PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III – PURPOSE(S)

This Corporation may, and is authorized to, engage in any not-for-profit activity or business under the laws of the United States of America and the State of Florida, and specifically to offer support services to parents educating their children through homeschooling. Specifically, providing record keeping of grades and transcripts, certified teachers to review portfolios, workshops, seminars, tutoring, field trips, summer camps, standardized testing, and any other service that may help parents of homeschoolers to best educate their children.

ARTICLE IV – MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

- A. The initial number of directors of this corporation shall be three (3).
- B. The number of directors of this corporation may be either increased or diminished from time to time by the board of directors in accordance with the bylaws of this corporation, but shall never be less than three (3).
- C. Directors as such shall receive compensation for their services, if any, and may be set out by the board of directors at any annual or special meeting thereof. The board of directors may authorize and require the payment of reasonable expenses incurred by directors attending meetings of the directors.

D. Nothing in this article shall be construed to preclude the directors from serving this corporation in any other capacity and receiving compensation therefrom.

E. The names and street addresses of the initial board of directors, each to hold office until the first annual meeting of the shareholders of the corporation or until their successors are elected or appointed and have qualified are:

F. Any director may be removed from office by the directors of this corporation in accordance with the bylaws of this corporation.

G. In case one or more vacancies shall occur in the board of directors by reason of death, resignations, or otherwise, the vacancies shall be filled by the remaining directors of this corporation in accordance with the bylaws of this corporation.

ARTICLE V – TERM OF EXISTENCE

The effective date upon which this corporation shall come into existence shall be upon acceptance by the Florida Office of Secretary of state, and it shall exist perpetually thereafter unless dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE IX – BYLAWS

The power to adopt, alter, amend, or repeal bylaws of this corporation shall be vested in the board of directors of this corporation.

ARTICLE X – ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the Corporation shall be turned over to another 501 (C)(3) organization serving Homeschooling families.

ARTICLE XI – NO DISCRIMINATION

In selection of officers, directors, agents, or employees, and in carrying out the purposes of this Corporation, there shall be no discrimination as to race, creed, sex or handicap.
