ARTICLE I

<u>Name</u>

ARTICLE III

<u>Membership</u>

There will be no membership in the corporation.

ARTICLE IV

Term of Existence

The term of existence of this corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE V

ARTICLE X

By-Laws

Section 1. The initial By-Laws of the corporation shall be adopted by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

Section 2. The By-Laws may be made, amended or rescinded by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE XI

Amendments

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE XII

Negation of Pecuniary Gain

This corporation is not organized for a pecuniary profit. It shall not have any power to issue Certificates of Stock or declare dividends. No part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to, any member, director, officer or other private persons; provided, however, that this shall not be construed to prohibit the payment by the corporation of reasonable compensation for services rendered or to prohibit payments and distributions by the corporation in furtherance of its purposes as described in Article II hereof.

ARTICLE XIII

Prohibition of Certain Activities

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE XIV

<u>Dissolution</u>

Upon the dissolution of this corporation in accordance with Florida law, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of this corporation, distribute the remaining assets of this corporation for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any assets not disposed of as provided above shall be

disposed of by the Circuit Court of Palm Beach County, or any other court having jurisdiction over this corporation in regard to its dissolution.
