ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I - CORPORATE NAME AND PRINCIPAL ADDRESS

The name of this corporation is FOOT SOLDIERS FOR CHRIST OUTREACH
MINISTRIES, INCORPORATED, and the principal address of the corporation is 203.50 three 54

ARTICLE II - TERMS OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSES FOR WHICH THE CORPORATION IS ORGANIZED

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes as set forth in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that quality as tax exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of such code, or any corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax law.

ARTICLE IV - PROHIBITED TRANSACTIONS

This corporation shall not:

- A. Engage in any activities prohibited by Section 617.0835, Florida Statutes;
- B. As a substantial part of its activities, carry out propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation;
- C. Participate or intervene, by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise, in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office;

D. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE V - DEDICATION OF ASSETS

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable, religious, and educational purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof.

ARTICLE VI - MEMBERSHIP

The corporation shall have a membership distinct from the Board of Directors. Any person making application for membership as provided for in the Bylaws and agreeing to be bound by the Articles of Incorporation of this corporation, by its Bylaws, and by such rules and regulations as the Board of Directors may from time to time adopt, is eligible for membership in the corporation. The Board of Directors shall from time to time prescribe the form and manner in which application may be made for membership. ARTICLE X - MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

The powers of this corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs conducted by a Board of Directors. The number of directors of the corporation shall be not less than four (4) and may be such number greater than four (4) as may, from time to time, be voted upon by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE XI - AMENDMENTS

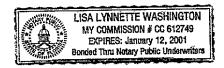
