## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

### ARTICLE I                      NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

REACH Out Resource Fund, Inc.

### ARTICLE II                      PRINCIPAL OFFICE

### ARTICLE III                      PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

REACH Out Resource Fund, Inc. is organized exclusively for educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The corporation's services will be limited to assisting under-privileged children improve reading and language skills to a level commensurate with their age and grade. Each child will be evaluated to determine current reading and language skills level. This assessment will then be used to develop an Individualized Education Plan. The Individualized Educational Plan becomes the road map for developing specific skills and monitoring progress throughout the program.

### ARTICLE IV                      MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed:

The directors of the corporation are elected by the shareholders. Each shareholder is entitled to one vote per share owned.

ARTICLE VIII DEDICATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IX NONDISCRIMINATORY POLICY

The corporation will admit students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities that will be available at the school. The corporation does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, scholarship and loan programs and any other administered programs.

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ARTICLE X      OTHER

The corporation will distribute its income for each tax year at a time and in a manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.


The corporation will not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The corporation will not retain any excess business holdings as defined in section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.


The corporation will not make any investments in a manner as to subject it to tax under section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
