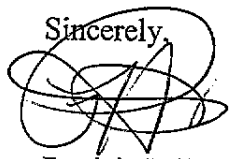

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
FOR
FEMALES ON A MISSION, INC.
(A Not-For-Profit Corporation)**

We, the undersigned, being competent to contract and desirous of forming a corporation for non-profit purposes under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, do agree and submit the following as and for our Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation shall be **FEMALES ON A MISSION, INC.** Its principal place of business shall be 3601 W. Commercial Blvd., Suite 35, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33309.

ARTICLE II - TERMS OF EXISTENCE

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence, unless dissolved sooner by operation of law or by corporate resolution.

ARTICLE III- PURPOSE

The general nature of the objects and purposes of this corporation are exclusively religious, charitable, and educational within the meaning of Section 501 ©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future U.S. Internal Revenue laws. To the end that the foregoing purposes and any other related religious, charitable, and educational purposes may be carried out, performed and accomplished, this corporation shall have those powers afforded not-for-profit corporations by the applicable laws of the State of Florida and those powers exclusively expressed in the By-laws of the corporation.

These Articles may be amended, altered, or rescinded by a majority vote of the members present at a regular or special meeting of the corporation, provided all notice and quorum requirements are met.

ARTICLE XII-REGISTERED AGENT AND ACCEPTANCE

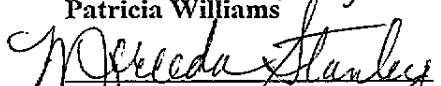

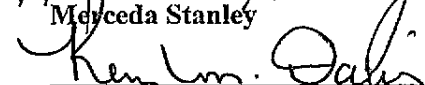

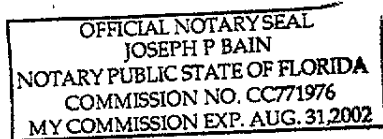
