ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF J CLARK CHARITABLE ART FOUNDATION, INC.

A FLORIDA NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 647, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation of such corporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

J CLARK CHARITABLE ART FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

J CLARK CHARITABLE ART FOUNDATION, INC. 102 14TH Street E Bradenton, FL 34208

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

<u>ARTICLE IV - MEMBERS AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS</u>

The membership, initially shall consist of all members of the Board of Directors and all those who shall be elected to membership by the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors may from time to time establish qualifications for membership and voting.

ARTICLE V - MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors. The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed shall be that they are appointed by the Board Members during the First Meeting of the Members.

The number constituting the initial Board of Directors of the corporation shall be determined at the First Meeting of the Members.
