Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617 of the Florida Statutes, the undersigned corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to the Articles of Incorporation:

- The Board of Directors of the Corporation wishes to change the Articles of 1. Incorporation
- Therefore, Article III, Article IV and Article VI of the Corporation's Articles of Incorporation shall be deleted in its entirety and the following inserted in its place:

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE(S)

- 2. All other provisions of the Corporation's Articles of Incorporation shall remain in full force and effect, unaltered except as expressly provided above.
