The name of the corporation is African Culture Exchange, Inc.

Article III

The purpose of this corporation is as follows

A This Corporation is a Not-For-Profit Corporation organized under Chapter 17, Florida Statutes. It is not organized for the private gain of any person. The specific purpose of the Corporation is as follows
