ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

THE UNDERSIGNED, for the purpose of forming a corporation under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes (1997), pursuant to the Florida Not-for-Profit Corporation Act, hereby certify:

- 1. Name. The name of the Corporation is Bay County School Readiness Coalition, Inc.
- 2. Exempt Status. The Corporation has not been formed for pecuniary profit or financial gain, and no part of the assets, income, or profit of the Corporation is distributable to, or inures to the benefit of, its directors or officers except to the extent permitted under the Not-for-Profit Corporation Act. Notwithstanding any other provision of this certificate, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law).
- 3. Purposes. The purposes for which the Corporation is to be formed are for scientific, educational, and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and in this connection, to promote the welfare of children in home, school, and community, to raise the standards of academics; and to bring into closer relation the home and the school, that parents and teachers may cooperate intelligently in the training of children and more specifically with the business of owning and operating the Bay County School Readiness Coalition currently located at 450 Jenks Avenue, Panama City, Florida, and to these ends to take and hold by bequest, devise, gift, grant, purchase, lease or otherwise any property, real, personal, tangible or intangible, or any undivided interest therein, without limitation as to amount or value;

to sell, convey, or otherwise dispose of any such property and to invest, reinvest, or deal with the principal or the income thereof in such manner as, in the judgment of the directors, will best promote the purpose of the Corporation and the Panama City School Readiness Coalition without limitation, except such limitations, if any, as may be contained in the instrument under which such property is received, this Certificate of Incorporation, the Bylaws of the Corporation, or any laws applicable thereto. To do any other act or thing incidental to or connected with the foregoing purpose or in advancement thereof, but not for the pecuniary profit or financial gain of its directors or officers except as permitted under the Not-for-Profit Corporation Act. In furtherance of its corporate purposes, the Corporation shall have all general powers enumerated in Chapter 617, Florida Statutes entitled the Not-for-Profit Corporation Act.

- 4. <u>Initial and Registered Principal Office</u>. The street address, city and county in which the Corporation's office is to be located are: 450 Jenks Avenue, Panama City, Bay County, Florida 32405.
- 5. <u>Place of Operation</u>. The territory in which the Corporation's activities are principally to be conducted is Bay County, Florida.
