Articles of Incorporation Victory Baptist Church of Ft. Lauderdale Florida, Inc.

ATTAILED MASSON The undersigned incorporators, being natural persons over eighteen years of age, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article 1

The name of the corporation is Victory Baptist Church of Ft. Lauderdale Florida, Inc.

Article 2

The corporation is a not-for-profit corporation.

Article 3

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

Article 4

The corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law), including, but not limited to establishing and maintaining religious worship and operating a local New Testament Church in accordance with the bylaws of this organization.

Article 5

The street address of the registered office of the corporation is 3554 N.W. 32 street, Lauderdale Lakes, FL 33309, and the name of the registered agent located at such address is Keith A. Cunningham. The Principal address is the same.

Article 6

The corporation shall have members. The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by the board of directors. The number of the directors and how they will be elected shall be fixed by the bylaws of the corporation, but may not be less than (3).

Article 7

Article 8

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the tax-exempt purposes of the corporation set forth in Article 4.

Article 9

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Article 10

The corporation shall have a racially nondiscriminatory policy and therefore shall not discriminate against applicants, students, employees, and others on the basis of race, color, or national or ethnic origin.

Article 11

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the board of directors shall, after paying or making provision for payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, transfer all assets to a fund, foundation, or organization which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, religious, or educational purposes and at that time qualifies as an organization exempt from federal income taxation under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Article 12

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
