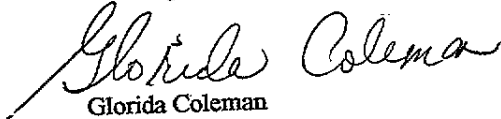

*The undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation pursuant to chapter 617, Florida Statutes,
adopt(s) the following:*

ARTICLE I

Purpose(s)

The specific purpose(s) for which this corporation is organized (are): exclusively for church affairs,
educational, social and charitable purposes.

ARTICLE IV

Limitation of corporate powers

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 6170302, Florida Statutes;
has perpetual duration and succession in the corporate name and has the same powers as an individual to do
all things necessary or convenient to carry out the corporate business and affairs, including without
limitation of power:

1. To sue and be sued, complain and defend in its corporate name;
2. To have a corporate seal, which may be altered at will and to use it or a facsimile of it by

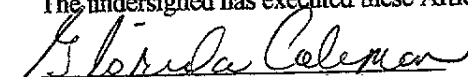
