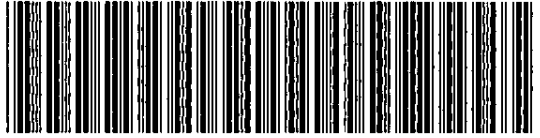

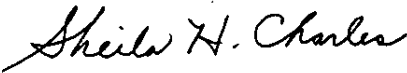

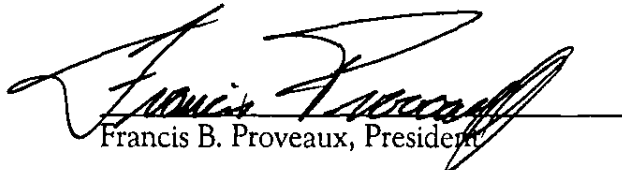
**Article III Purpose** is hereby amended to read:
