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# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

## WANDUK YACHAI 1 100.



#### **ARTICLE I. NAME**

The name of this corporation is WANDUK YACHAI, luc.

#### ARTICLE II. DURATION

The corporation shall have perpetual duration.

### ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

The corporation is a not for profit corporation. The general purposes for which this corporation is organized are:

- (a) To provide aid and financial assistance to educational, health-care, environmental monitoring and restoration, and programs promoting multiculturalism and biodiversity, based on knowledge, tradition, science, experience, and wisdom of the indigenous peoples and directly led by them.

distribution of any statements or otherwise, in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

#### ARTICLE IV - STOCK

The corporation is organized upon a nonstock basis as defined in Section 617.011 of the Florida Statutes. The corporation shall have a membership distinct from the board of directors. The authorized number and qualifications of members of the corporation, the manner of their admission, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting, and other rights and privileges of members, and their liability for dues and assessment and the method of collection thereof, shall be regulated in the bylaws.
