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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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OF
SHADY OAK VILLAS HOMEOWNER'S ASSOCIATION, PACLAHASSEE, FLORIDA
A corporation not-for-profit

Trifon Houvardas, acting as incorporator of a corporation not for profit under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, hereby adopt the following articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation is SHADY OAK VILLAS HOMEOWNER'S ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II. PURPOSES AND POWERS

The purposes and objects of the corporation are such as are authorized under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes and to maintain and operate common real property, to include, without limitation, the surface water management system as permitted by the Southwest Florida Water Management District, Permit No. MSW 4811578.00 including all ponds, retention areas, culverts and related appurtenances, of SHADY OAK VILLAS HOMEOWNER'S ASSOCIATION, INC., and to collect assessments for maintenance, management and other matters, in accordance with the terms of these articles of incorporation, the bylaws of this corporation, and the Deed Covenants and Restrictions recorded in the public records of Polk County, Florida, pertaining to SHADY OAK VILLAS HOMEOWNER'S ASSOCIATION, INC.

The corporation is authorized:

- (a) To own, rent, lease, operate and maintain sufficient real and personal property to include easements therein, to carry out the purposes hereinabove expressed.
- (b) To receive donations, gifts, or bequests of money or other property, and to accept the same, subject to such conditions or trusts as may be attached thereto, and to perform and execute any and all such conditions or trusts.
- (c) To contract debts and to borrow money, to issue, sell and pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidence of indebtedness.
 - (d) To establish rules and regulations.
 - (e) To sue and be sued.
- (f) To do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of the purposes or powers set forth in this article, and to do all other things incidental thereto or connected therewith, which are not forbidden by law or these articles of incorporation.
- (g) To carry out any of the purposes or powers set forth in this article in any state, territory, district, or possession of the United States of America, or in any foreign country, to the extent that such purposes are not forbidden by the law of such place.

The purposes or powers set forth in this article are not in limitation of the general powers conferred by non-profit corporation law of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III. MEMBERS

The qualification of the members, the manner of their admission to membership and termination of such membership, and voting by members shall be as follows:

- (a) The owners of all lots in SHADY OAK VILLAS HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC., shall be members of the corporation, and no other persons or entities to membership.
- (b) Membership shall be established upon execution and delivery of the Installment Land Contract or the acquisition of fee title to a lot, and the membership of any party shall be automatically terminated upon his being divested of title to all lots in aforesaid subdivision.
- (c) The interest of a member in the funds and assets of the corporation cannot be assigned, hypothecated or transferred in any manner, except as an appurtenance to his lot. The funds and assets of the corporation shall belong solely to the corporation subject to the limitation that the same be expended, held or used for the benefit of the membership and for the purposes authorized herein, in the By-Laws which may be hereafter adopted, and in the Deed Covenants and Restrictions which have been recorded in the public records of Polk County, Florida, covering SHADY OAK VILLAS HOMEOWNER'S ASSOCIATION, INC.
- (d) On all matters on which the membership shall be entitled to vote, there shall be one vote for each lot. Should any member own more than one lat, such member shall be entitled to exercise or cast as many votes as he owns lots.

ARTICLE IV. TERM OF EXISTENCE

The corporation is to exist perpetually, however, if the Association is dissolved, the property consisting of the surface water management system shall be conveyed to an appropriate agency of local government, and if not accepted, then the surface water management system shall be dedicated to a similar non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE V. ADDRESS

The street address and mailing address of the corporation in the State of Florida is 1582 Gulf Boulevard, Unit #1304, Clearwater, Florida 33767. The Board of Directors may from time to time move the principal office to any other address in Florida and may establish branch officers in such other place or places as may be designated by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VI. OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

- (a) The business affairs of this corporation shall be managed by the board of directors. This corporation shall have three (3) directors initially. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by the by-laws, but shall never be less than three.
- (b) The name and address of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of the membership of the corporation, are:

- (c) The officers shall be: a President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer and such other officers as the Board of Directors determines necessary. They shall be elected by the Board of Directors.
- (d) The officers and members of the Board of Directors shall perform such duties, hold office for such term, and take office at such time as shall be provided by the Bylaws of the Association.
 - (e) The method of election of directors shall be stated in the bylaws.

 ARTICLE VII. INCORPORATORS

ARTICLE VIII. ASSESSMENTS

The private property of the members shall not be subject to the payment of corporate debts of the corporation, provided, however, that this provision shall not in any manner limit the obligation of each member to the corporation as set forth and contained these Articles of Incorporation, the By-Laws which may be hereafter adopted, and the Deed Covenants, Restrictions and Easements affecting said lands in SHADY OAK VILLAS HOMEOWNER'S ASSOCIATION, INC., nor shall it limit the right of the corporation to levy and assess members for their proportionate share of the expenses of the corporation. The corporation shall be entitled to enforce collection of such assessments in such manner as may be reserved to the corporation in these Articles, said By-Laws and the protective Covenants, Restrictions and Easements.

ARTICLE IX. LIABILITY

Every director and officer of the corporation shall be indemnified by the corporation against all expenses and liabilities, including counsel fees, reasonably incurred by or imposed upon him in connection with any proceeding to which he may be a party, or in which he may become involved,

by reason fo his being or having been a director or officer at the time such expenses are incurred, except in such cases where the director or officer is adjudged guilty or willful malfeasance or misfeasance in the performance of his duties; provided that, in the event of any claim for reimbursement or indemnification hereunder based upon a settlement by the director or officer seeking such reimbursement or indemnification, the indemnification herein shall apply only if the Board of Directors approves such settlement and reimbursement as being in the best interest of the corporation. The foregoing right of indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of, all other rights to which such director or officer may be entitled.

ARTICLE X. AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION AND BY-LAWS

The corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or appeal any provision contained these articles of incorporation in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by law. Each amendment submitted to the members for approval must be approved by majority of the members entitled to vote thereon.

ARTICLE XI. NON-PROFIT CHARACTER

No person, firm, or corporation shall ever receive any dividends or profits from the undertaking of this corporation, and upon dissolution of this organization, all of its assets remaining after payment of all costs and expenses of such dissolution shall be distributed to organizations which have qualified for exemption under Section 501 (c) of the Internal Revenue Code, to the Federal Government or to a state or local government, for a public purpose, and none of the assets will be distributed to any member, officer, or trustee of this organization.

ARTICLE XII. REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The corporation hereby designates as its registered office 1582 Gulf Boulevard, Unit #1304, Clearwater, Florida 33767, and its registered agent, Trifon Houvardas, at the same address, for service of process.
