

Articles Of Incorporation for Lady Cudas Basketball Booster Club Organization, INC

Of MILED AND.

Article 1

1.1 The name of this corporation shall be Lady Cudas Basketball Booster Club Organization, TNC.

1.2The principle address of Lady Cudas Basketball Booster Club Organization shall be P.O. Box 562043
Miami, Florida 33256

Article 2

2.1The purpose of this corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which a corporation may be organized under the General Corporation Law of Florida other than the banking business or the practice of a profession permitted to be incorporated by the Florida Corporations Code. This corporation will endeavor in working with the Coral Reef Senior High School Girl's Basketball Team, by providing selective equipment, such as shoes, t-shirts, sweat suits, socks, sport bags, etc. The booster club will also raise funds in order to send the team to sporting events, sports clinics, and camps throughout the year.

Article 3

3.1The liability of the officers and directors of this corporation for monetary damages will be eliminated to the fullest extent permissible under Florida Law.

This corporation is authorized to provide indemnification of agents (as defined in Article 617 of the Florida Corporations Code) for breach of duty to the corporation and it's shareholders through bylaw provisions or through Agreements with the agents, or through shareholder resolutions, otherwise, in excess of the indemnification permitted by Article 617 of the Corporation's Code, subject to the limits on such excess indemnification set forth in Article 617.0302 Florida Statutes of the Corporation's Code.

Article 4

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed are as follows:

• The directors shall be elected by members of the booster club via popular vote.

Article 5

Article 6

Lady Cudas Basketball Booster Club Organization is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, or religious purposes, within the meaning of section 501 ©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article 7

No part of the net earnings or the corporation/organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation/organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501 ©(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation/organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation/organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Not withstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation/organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation/organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (of corresponding section of any future Federal tax code) or (b) by a corporation/organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.)

Article 8

Upon dissolution of this corporation/organization's assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, i.e. Charitable, educational, religious, or scientific of corresponding section of any future federal tax code, of shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose.

Article 9

However, if the named recipient is not then in existence or no longer a qualified distributee, or unwilling or unable to accept the distribution, then the assets of this corporation/organization shall be distributed to a fund, foundation or corporation organized and operated exclusively for the purposes specified in Section 501 ©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code(or corresponding section of any future Federal tax.
