

Articles of Incorporation of the undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of Florida, do hereby certify:

Article I: The name of the Corporation shall be **Front Line Word Ministries, Inc.**

Article II: The place in this state where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located is the City of Tampa, Hillsborough County.

Article III: Said corporation is organized exclusively for religious purposes which includes educational and charitable functions. For such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article IV: Trustees are appointed according to their interest and desire to help in the fulfillment of the mission statement of said corporation. These trustees are appointed by the president of said corporation and reviewed at the annual meeting. The names and addresses of the persons who are the initial trustees of the corporation are as follows:

Article V: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. The corporation shall not attempt to influence legislation or participate in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.


political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. The corporation shall not participate in any activity not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.


Article VI: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine and which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.






