• Article III Purpose:

Section A, General: This Corporation is organized exclusively for educational and charitable purposes within the guidelines of Section (501)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. To this end, the corporation shall develop alternative educational programs and provide quality curriculum within the following areas:

- Motivation/Inspiration lectures/seminars
- Life Skill Behavior Skill
- Living Values Values to live by
- Basic Business Training
- Social Competence
- Problem Solving
- Character Development
