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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF'

THE AMANDA SMITH FOUNDATION, INC.

The undersigned incorporator hereby forms a corporation not for profit pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes (the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act) and adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I -- NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: THE AMANDA SMITH FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE II -- PLACE OF BUSINESS

The initial address of the principal office and place of business of this corporation shall be 4710 North Willis St., Tampa, FL 33603 and the mailing address of the corporation shall be 4710 North Willis St., Tampa, FL 33603. The principal address and mailing address may change from time to time.

ARTICLE III -- NATURE OF BUSINESS

This not for profit corporation is created for the purpose of and intends to engage in activities involving public and private education and awareness applicable to the danger, treatment and prevention of melanoma, assistance to patients and families who are affected by melanoma, and possible further contributions to melanoma cancer research and lobbying for public

and private funding dealing with the cause, treatment, and public awareness of melanoma.

ARTICLE IV -- DIRECTORS

There shall be a minimum of three (3) directors with the number specified in or fixed in accordance with these articles or the bylaws. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by amendment to, or in the manner provided in, the bylaws, but the corporation must never have fewer than three directors. Directors shall be elected or appointed in the manner and for the terms provided and stated in the bylaws.

ARTICLE V -- REGISTERED AGENT

limitation set forth in these Articles of Incorporation and the bylaws.

The corporation may have one or more classes of members or may have no members as subsequently set forth in the bylaws, and any amendments thereto. The designation of classes of members, if any, qualifications and rights of the members of such class, any quorum and voting requirements for meetings and activities of the members, and notice requirements shall be set forth in the bylaws.
