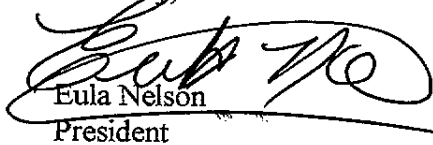

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
UNITED CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP MINISTRIES, INC.**

ARTICLE 1. - NAME

The name of this Corporation is: **United Christian Fellowship Ministries, Inc.**

The principal place of worship is: **620 SW 8th Court, Delray Beach, FL 33444**

The mailing address is: **c/o Frank McCaskill Sr. 3001 NW 24th ST, Ft. Lauderdale, FL 33311**

ARTICLE 2. - TERM

The Corporation shall have Perpetual Existence.

ARTICLE 3. - PURPOSE/s

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, and educational, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future United States of Internal Revenue Law.

This organization is a Not-For-Profit Corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for religious purposes.

ARTICLE 4. - SPECIFIC PURPOSES

The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate for the advancement of religion, charity and education, and for other charitable purposes, by the distribution of its funds for such purposes, and particularly to practice, teach, preach and support the precepts and teachings of Christianity, according to the New Testament, among the people of the State of Florida and to that end and purpose, to provide means of caring for the indigent and needy; to provide wholesome recreation for youth, homes for the aged; and hospitalization and medical care for the sick; and to provide and conduct suitable funerals and burials for their death.

The United Christian Fellowship Ministries will provide Preschool, Pre-kindergarten, Kindergarten and Elementary grades.

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ARTICLE 5. - REGISTERED AGENT

ARTICLE 6. - DIRECTORS

The initial Board of Directors will consist of four (4) directors. The number of Directors may be increased or decreased, but, shall never be less than three (3), nor more than fifteen (15) as may be designated from time to time by resolution of a majority of the entire Board.

ARTICLE 7. - ORGANIZATION

A) This Corporation is organized and operated for religious, charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

B) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

C) No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE 8. - CORPORATE ASSETS

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, assets remaining after payment or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes, and which as established its tax exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE 9. - MEMBERSHIP

The Corporation shall have a membership distinct from the Board of Trustees. The authorized number and qualifications, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting and other rights and privileges of members, and their liability for dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof, shall be set forth in the Bylaws. The qualification for membership in this corporation shall be a confessed belief in the principals and teachings of Christianity, and a desire to participate and assist in the promotion of its principals and purposes among all mankind, and to that end and purpose, all persons, men and women, boys and girls, having good moral character, or the desire for it, shall be welcome to membership.

The manner of admission of members shall be by certificate of approval from the Board of Directors, and may be further prescribed and regulated in the rules and regulations adopted from time to time by the voting membership of the Corporation, and members may be dismissed for such causes and in such manner as may be provided by such rules and regulations.

ARTICLE 10 - OFFICERS

The Officers of the Corporation shall consist of a President, Secretary and Treasurer, each of which shall be appointed by the Board of Directors and may be removed by the Board of Directors.
