

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION
(non-profit)
FOR
HOMESTEAD CHURCH OF THE NAZARENE

TO: The Honorable Judges of the Circuit Court of the Eleventh
Judicial Circuit in and for Dade County, Florida.

We the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves together
for the purpose of becoming incorporated under the laws of the
State of Florida, applicable to corporations not for profit, under
the following proposed Charter:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be known as HOMESTEAD
CHURCH OF THE NAZARENE.

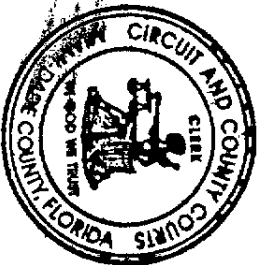
ARTICLE II - OBJECT

The general nature of the object of this corporation is
to conduct for religious worship and instruction churches, schools,
and other institutions connected therewith of a religious, educ-
ational, charitable and benevolent character to the end that its
own members and others may be generally instructed and guided
concerning the teachings of Christ, the Bible, those Articles of
Faith which are most surely held among the Church of the Nazarene,
and the Manual of the Church of the Nazarene; and to advance
spiritual growth and enlightenment, moral and heart purity among
its own members and the people of the community in which it is
located to promote the unity, the purity, and the victory of the
Gospel of Jesus Christ, and to aid in the spread of the same to
the ends of the earth.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

The present membership of the Homestead Church of the
Nazarene, (unincorporated), of Homestead, Florida, and those
hereafter admitted to such membership shall constitute the mem-
bership of this corporation.

All persons who have been publicly received by the
pastor, the District Superintendent, or the General Superintendent.



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after having declared their experience of salvation, and their belief in the doctrines of the Church of the Nazarene, and their willingness to submit to its government, shall compose the full membership of the corporation; provided, however, that only church members who have attained to their twelfth birthday shall be entitled to vote in the annual or special church meeting.

When, at any time, there are persons who desire to unite with the church, which automatically entitles them to membership in this corporation, having been favorably considered by the Membership Committee after consultation with the pastor, the minister, or membership committee shall meet with the applicants and explain to them briefly the privileges of membership in the church and especially with reference to the General Rules, and question them in reference to their faith and experience, receive them into church membership.

Membership shall be further governed by such other provisions and limitations as may be provided for in the Manual of the Church of the Nazarene, as may be amended from time to time.

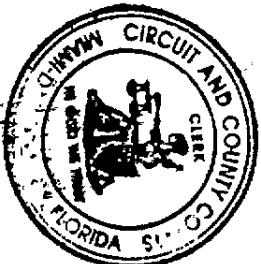
ARTICLE IV - TERM

ARTICLE VI - OFFICERS

The business affairs of this corporation shall be managed by the church board, such management to be subject to the approval of the Church, and said Board to be composed of the pastor, who shall be, ex officio chairman, the Sunday-school superintendent, the president of the Nazarene Young People's Society, the president of the local Nazarene Foreign Missionary Society, the stewards, and the trustees of the local church, (Secretary & Treasurer).

The stewards of the local church shall be not fewer than three nor more than thirteen in number. They shall be elected by ballot, at the annual or special church meeting, from among the members of the local church, to serve for the next church year and until their successors have been elected and qualified.

The trustees of the local church shall be not fewer than three nor more than nine in number. They shall be elected from among the members of the Homestead Church of the Nazarene to serve for the next church year and until their successors have been elected and qualified. All the property of this corporation shall be managed and controlled by the trustees subject to the approval of the local church.

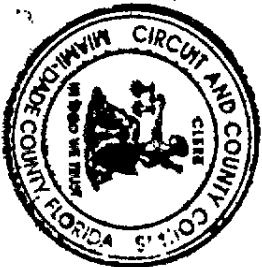

ARTICLE VIII - By-Laws

The By-laws of the corporation are to be made, altered or recinded upon a majority vote of the members present any any annual meeting of the corporation. The By-laws are at all times to be in conformity with the Manual of the Church of the Nazarene.

The highest amount of indebtedness or liability to which the corporation may at any time subject itself, which shall never be greater than two-thirds of the value of the property of the corporation, shall be ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000.00). The indebtedness of the corporation shall be further limited and controlled in accordance with the Manual of the Church of the Nazarene.

ARTICLE X - VALUE OF REAL ESTATE

The amount in value of the real estate which the corporation may hold, subject always to the approval of the Circuit Judge shall be TWO MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000.00).

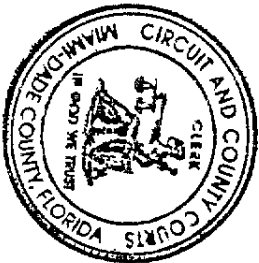

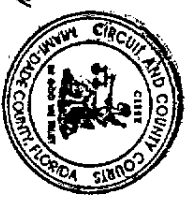

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed:

The business affairs of the corporation shall be managed and directed by a Church Board of Directors composed of the Pastor who shall be, ex officio, Chairman, the Sunday School Superintendent, the President of the Nazarene Young People's Society, the President of the local Nazarene Foreign Missionary Society, the Stewards and the Trustees of the local Church, the Secretary of the Church and the Treasurer. The Stewards of the local Church shall be not fewer than three (3) no more than thirteen (13) and shall be elected by ballot at the annual or at a special church meeting from among the members of the local church. The Trustees of the local Church shall be not fewer than three (3) no more than nine (9) and shall be elected from among the members of the local Church at the annual or at a special church meeting. The Sunday School Superintendent, Secretary and Treasurer of the Church shall be appointed by the Church Board of Directors. The President of the Nazarene Young People's Society shall be elected by said society in accordance with their rules of organization and the President of the local Nazarene Foreign Missionary Society shall be elected by said society in accordance with their rules of organization.

ARTICLE V MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

This corporation hereby readopts the provisions contained in the original Certificate of Incorporation filed on the 7th day of October, 1955, and recorded in Corporation Record Book 79, at page 424, of the public records of Miami-Dade County, which provisions are not otherwise specifically amended by this reincorporation or prohibited by Florida Law.
