## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

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## JACKSONVILLE MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY & SCIENCE, INC.

(A Corporation Not for Profit)

TALLAHASSEE FLORIDA

The Articles of Incorporation of the undersigned, who is a citizen of the United States, desiring to form a not-for-profit Corporation under Chapter 617, of the not-for-profit Corporation Laws of Florida, does hereby certify:

The name of the corporation shall be JACKSONVILLE ARTICLE I: MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY & SCIENCE, INC.

Principal Place of Business. The place in this state where the principal ARTICLE II: office of the Corporation is to be located is 3504 Stanley Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32207, with a mailing address of the same.

Purposes. The sole purpose for which this corporation is organized is for ARTICLE III: scientific, literary, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The corporation shall be operated exclusively and in furtherance of such purpose.

Dedication and Distribution of Assets. No part of the net earnings of the ARTICLE IV: corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Board of Directors. The number of initial directors of this corporation is ARTICLE V: five (5). The manner in which the directors are appointed will be as stated in the bylaws of the corporation. Their names and addresses are as follows:
