The undersigned, acting as incorporator of the **PANTHER YOUTH BASEBALL, INC.** ("Corporation") under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, submits the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the Corporation is: **PANTHER YOUTH BASEBALL, INC..**

ARTICLE II. ADDRESS

The street address of the initial principal office and the mailing address of the Corporation are 3210 SW 103rd Court, Miami, Fl 33165.

ARTICLE III. DURATION AND COMMENCEMENT

The Corporation will exist perpetually, commencing on the date these Articles of Incorporation are executed, unless the filing of these Articles of Incorporation occurs more than five (5) business days thereafter, in which event such existence commences on the date of filing of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE IV. PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized as a corporation not-for-profit, exclusively for religious, charitable, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE V. INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Corporation shall not have less than three (3) directors initially. The number of directors may be either increased or diminished from time to time, as provided in the bylaws, but will never be less than three (3). The method of election or appointment of the directors shall be as provided in the bylaws. The names and addresses of the initial board of directors are:

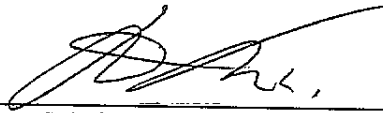

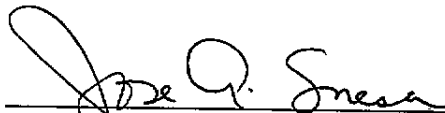
