Articles of Incorporation Of X-Club Alumni Association, Inc.

I, the undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, do hereby form a corporation not-for-profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the corporation is:

ARTICLE II REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The address of the registered office in the State of Florida is 213 West Comstock Avenue, in the City of Winter Park, County of Orange. The name of the registered agent at such address is Richard F. Trismen.

ARTICLE III NATURE OF BUSINESS

- will be to perpetuate a social and fraternal organization at Rollins College, formed in 1928, and known as the X-Club; to sponsor and encourage the restoration of the X-Club as a fraternal organization at Rollins College, to provide the X-Club organization with guidelines and standards upon which it will govern itself, recruit members, participate and provide leadership in student social and academic activities, student government, intramural and interscholastic athletics, community volunteer activities, and support the academic, social, athletic and leadership ideals of Rollins College.
- **B.** No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, officer of the corporation, or any private individual, except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation affecting one or more of its purposes, and no member or officer of the corporation, or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the

distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in, including the publication or distribution of statements, any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

assets of the corporation shall be distributed exclusively to one or more charitable, religious, scientific, testing for public safety, literary, or educational organizations, which would then qualify under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may be hereafter amended, or to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IV TERM OF EXISTENCE

The corporation shall have perpetual existence, commencing on the date of execution of these Articles, if they shall be filed with the Florida Department of State within five days after execution, and if not, commencing on the date of such filing.

ARTICLE V ADDRESS

The initial street address of the principal office of this corporation is to be 213 West Comstock Avenue, Winter Park, Florida 32789. The Board of Directors may from time to time designate such other address and place for the principal office of this corporation as it may see fit, and it may establish branch and other offices within \overline{or} without the State of Florida.

ARTICLE VI MEMBERSHIP

A. Membership in the corporation shall be open to men of high moral and ethical character and reputation who adhere to the traditions and goals of the social club founded at Rollins College in 1928, originally known as the "Duke's" and later as the X-Club, and who are supportive of the Rollins College educational mission.

- **B.** Membership shall be limited to those individuals who are elected by a majority vote of the members of the Board of Directors, which shall have the exclusive authority over the eligibility and election of Members.
- C. Standards and principles of Membership eligibility and election shall be established from time to time by the Board of Directors and set forth in the Bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE VII BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed and controlled by a Board of Directors, comprised of not fewer than Three (3) and not more than Fifteen (15) members. Directors need not be residents of the State of Florida and shall be elected in accordance with the Bylaws of the corporation.
