ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT to ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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of UPPER ROOM OUTREACH MINISTRIES OF MIAMI, INCAHASSEE, FLORIDA

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Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: The following article is hereby added:

Article X: Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of this Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the remaining assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such manner or to such corporations, or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall have qualified as exempt corporations or organizations pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or of the corresponding provisions of any subsequent Internal Revenue statute) as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the state where the principal office of the Corporation is then located for the purposes for which this Corporation was organized or to such corporations or organizations which the court determines are organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes in accordance with the above-referenced statute.

SECOND: The date of adoption of the amendment was March 2, 2004.

THIRD: There are no members entitled to vote on the amendment. Therefore, the amendment was adopted by the board of directors.
