- (b) To help integrate programs of cancer research investigation by organizing a team of Ph.D.'s and M.D.'s.
- (c) To specifically raise money for the purpose of financing local and national activities to promote a comprehensive research attack on the problem of cancer and related conditions.
- (d) To provide funds for education of young scientists to be especially in the medical field of cancer research in high school, undergraduate college students, graduate students, including doctorate candidates [pre-doctoral and post-doctoral] in the fields of oncology, molecular biology and biochemistry.
- (e) To develop model cancers that can be used to find cures and vaccines against cancer in animals and tissue culture including human cancer models.

 [Dr. Lampkin-Asam is the original developer of the P1798 model lymphomas and the author of LYMPHOMAS: Regression, Carcinogenesis and Prevention, 1966, Model Lymphomas, 1976, and P1798 Model Lymphomas Sensitive and Resistant to Glucocorticoids: DNA and RNA Induced Lymphomas: Review, 2001, and many other publications on cancer research.]
- (f) To operate a cancer institute exclusively for charitable, medical scientific, and educational purposes for the public interest, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations - under 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 2001.
- (g) The Institute and no individual shall receive or be entitled to receive any pecuniary profit from the operation of the Institute except reasonable compensation for services.
- (h) To exercise all such power and authority as may be necessary to carry out the purpose and essence of this corporation; it is expressly declared that this is a CORPORATION NOT FOR PROFIT or individual gain and that no dividend shall ever be declared or paid to any of its members and that none of its property, real or personal, shall ever be used or expended except by carrying into effect the legitimate ends and aims of its being. In addition to this Charter of Articles of Incorporation, the corporation shall be governed by its By-Laws and any amendments thereto.
