## Article VIII Management of Museum Properties:

The purpose of this Article is to inform the public concerning the management and preservation of valuable objects and relics relating thereto:

- Donations and bequests of money and/or other personal property shall be held, used, expended and administered for the purposes of this article.
- Use of donations and bequests of money shall be used to purchase and maintain; museum objects, museum collections, and other personal properties at prices considered to be reasonable or fair market price.
- Making loans of museum objects to responsible private or public organizations, institutions, agencies, and/or museums as shall be considered advisable and under such terms and conditions which shall be considered reasonably necessary to protect the museum's interest in such properties.

# Article IX Disposal of unnecessary or duplicate objects; use of proceeds

The directors or their duly appointed representatives may exercise the authorities written in the bylaws and may dispose of objects no longer needed for the museum or held in duplicate among museum properties and apply the proceeds to the purchase of museum objects, museum collections, and other personal properties at reasonable prices. The US Army reg. 870-20 "Historical Activities, Museums, and Historical Artifacts" shall be used as a guideline.
