### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

for

# CENTER FOR MEMORY DISORDERS, INC. (A Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation)

#### I. NAME

The name of this Corporation is "Center for Memory Disorders, Inc." (hereinafter called the "Corporation").

#### II. ADDRESS

The address of the principal office and the mailing address of the Corporation shall be 633 East Colonial Drive, Orlando, Florida 32803.

#### III. DURATION

The period of the duration of the Corporation is perpetual unless dissolved according to law.

#### IV. PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized and operating for charitable and education purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as subsequently amended. Specifically, the Corporation has a mission of diagnosing, treating, and educating the public with issues relating to cognitive memory and related disorders, and any and all such other purposes as may be deemed appropriate by the Board of Directors of the corporation.

#### V. POWERS

The Corporation shall have the power to acquire, own, maintain and use its assets for the purposes for which it is organized; to raise funds by any legal means for the encouragement of its purposes; to acquire, hold, own, use and dispose of real or personal property in connection with the purposes of the Corporation; to exercise all powers necessary or convenient to the furtherance of the purposes for which the Corporation is organized; and to exercise all powers granted to a corporation not-for-profit under Florida law. In addition to the powers specified, the Corporation shall have the additional powers specified in its bylaws.



#### VI. MANAGEMENT

Management of the Corporation shall be vested in the Corporation's Board of Directors, the members of which shall be not less than three. The number and method of election of the Directors of the Corporation who shall serve following the terms of the initial Directors of the Corporation, shall be as stated in the bylaws.

#### VII. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The initial Board of Directors of the Corporation shall be appointed by the Incorporator at the organizational meeting of the Corporation.

#### VIII. MEMBERSHIP

The Corporation shall have one or more classes of members, who shall be admitted to membership pursuant to such criteria and procedures as shall be stated in the bylaws.

#### IX. DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax codes, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of Orange County, Florida, or the jurisdictional court of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

#### X. DISTRIBUTION OF NET EARNINGS

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, Directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV hereof.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax, under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The Board of Directors of the Corporation may amend these Articles of Incorporation as it may deem necessary for the conduct of its business and the carrying out of its purposes.

Upon written or oral notice, the Articles of Incorporation may be amended, altered, or rescinded by a majority vote of the Board of Directors of the Corporation, in accordance with procedures established by the Bylaws.
