Article III: The purpose of the Group is:

1. To assist, fulfill and provide social economic needs of the subsidized housing residents of Norton Apartments in Clearwater, FL.
2. To promote and encourage the youth of the community to have a spirit of high morals and strong positive character, positive communication, good attitude and a strong support system for youth and their families in our community.
3. To promote the need for recreational, educational and social activities that are designed to provide cultural experiences and unify the multigenerational gap within the neighborhood.
4. To collaborate with other agencies within the whole community to provide human services for residents that bridges empowering information to families who are having hardships in order to improve the welfare of the family and community.

Article IV: The manner of elected, appointed and decision making will be as follows:

- A. All elections, appointed and decision making of this organizations shall be by majority rules (which means that decisions are made based on the majority, or more than half of the officers/member voting).
1. All appointed individuals, or committees must be nominated by one of the officers of the organization, come before the group by a form of meeting, and voted in by the group members present
  2. Absentee ballots will be given per written request for the absent voter, and return to the President and/or Secretary to include in elections, appointment, and decision making.
- B. Quorum
1. The minimum number of members present to make decisions will be Five.

2. Must be at least 18 years of age or head of household, children and spouses per unit are associated members


B. Terms of Officers

1. Each officer should serve a term of three years, unless reelected. The maximum number of terms is three and you can return if elected after one term.
2. If any officer should move from Norton Apartments, they can no longer serve as an officer, either the Vice or Assistant should replace them or someone will be elected by the membership for the rest of the term. However, they may serve on a committee, for advice and training purposes.
2. There must be at least three officers who signatures on the bank account for all financial transactions (checks and withdrawals).  
The three officers are the (1) President (2) Secretary (3) Treasurer

C. Committees Members


1. Committee members can be appointed by officers, a decision making process will be conducted to confirmed by members and/or officers.

3. The terms of a committee member should be two years and no more than two terms. However, a committee member can serve again two years after its last term.
