Article I. Name

- A. The name of the organization shall be the Humane Society of Taylor County, Inc, a nonprofit corporation (hereafter "society"). The principle place of business shall be Taylor County, Florida and the society shall serve the Taylor County Area, and the City of Perry.
- B. The purpose of the Society shall be:
- To extend humane education together with such allied purposes and programs as consistent with or as may subsequently come into being as a result of amending the charter and/or bylaws of this society;
- 2. To support the improvement of all anti-cruelty and animal control laws;
- 3. To work toward the solution of overpopulation of animals;
- 4. To promote foster adoption programs;
- 5. To promote and share responsibility for proper care and placement of animals;
- 6. To shelter abused, neglected, and homeless animals, and to help with prevention of cruelty to all animals.

Article II. Membership

- 1. Any adult person (18 years)shall be eligible for membership in the Society and shall become a member upon completion of the Society application form and payment in full of annual dues.
- 2. The annual dues shall be \$10.00 and shall be payable upon entrance and again on a yearly basis due one year from the original membership date. All paid dues are non-refundable.

- 3. The treasurer and/or membership chairman working cohesively shall notify member's delinquent by one month in their dues, and those members shall forfeit membership on the fifteenth of the following month. Any reinstatement will be as a new member with any membership fee increases due.
- 4. Payment of dues will be given to the membership chairman where the name and dues will be given to the treasurer at that time.

Article III – Officers

- 1. The officers of the Society shall be a president, vice-president, treasurer, secretary, and membership chairman.
- 2. The officers shall perform the duties described in the parliamentary authority and Management Resources voted in by the general membership and these bylaws.
- 3. Each officer shall be elected by ballot at the annual meeting to serve a term designated by each office held.

President 2 Years
Vice President 2 Years
Treasurer 1 Year
Secretary 1 Year
Membership chair 1 Year

The executive board will appoint chairpersons (I.e. Fundraiser, Medical Advisors, Veterinarian Advisors.)

The Directors are selected according to the by-laws.

No person shall hold office if he is not a member, and no members shall hold more than one office at a time.

Article IV - Meeting

- 1. A regular meeting go the Society shall be held on the second Monday of every month, unless the Society orders otherwise in advance. The President is the only officer who will cancel a meeting unless incapacitated.
- 2. The regular meeting in January shall be known as the annual meeting and shall be for the purpose of electing officers, receiving annual reports, and conducting any other business that may arise.
- 3. A special meeting may be held upon the call of the president or on the written request of any twenty members of the Society. The purpose of the meeting shall be set forth in the notice.
- 4. The 5 elected board members may make decisions without the vote of the general membership when it concerns the day to day decisions. Or purchases that are under a \$5000.00 value.
- 5. No notice shall be required for a regular meeting except the annual meeting, which shall require notice of a least twenty-five days. Notice of a special meeting shall be given at least three days in advance.
- 6. One fourth of the membership will constitute a quorum.

Article VI - Parliamentary Authority

1. The rules contained in the Modern Edition of Robert's rules of Order shall govern the Society in all cases where they are not inconsistent with these bylaws and any special rules of order the Society may adopt.

Article VII - Amendments

1. These bylaws may be amended at any regular or special meeting of the Society by a two thirds vote, provided that previous notice of the amendment was given to all members at least eight days in advance.
