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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

<u>OF</u>

FOUNDATION TO SUPPORT MOTHER AND UNBORN CHILD, INC.

I.

The name of the corporation is "FOUNDATION TO SUPPORT MOTHER AND UNBORN CHILD, INC."

II.

The corporation is organized pursuant to the provisions of the <u>Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act</u>.

III.

The corporation shall have perpetual duration.

IV.

The corporation is a nonprofit corporation and is organized for the follow purposes:

- (a) To provide a proceeds and methods for providing support for mothers and their unborn child or children,
 - (b) To engage in any lawful activity related thereto, and
- (c) To engage in any other lawful activity for which corporations may be organized under the <u>Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act</u>.

V.

The corporation shall not have members.

VI.

The initial registered office and the mailing address of the initial principal office

of the corporation shall be at 432 High Street, Boca Raton, Florida 33432, and the initial registered agent of the corporation at such address shall be: Vera Verna.

VII.

The initial Board of Directors shall consist of three (3) members, the names and addresses of whom are as follows.

The name and address of the incorporator is Vera Verna, 432 High Street, Boca Raton, Florida 33432.

IX.

The object and purpose of this corporation is to acquire and administer funds and property which, after the payment of necessary expenses, shall be devoted exclusively to religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and/or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) including, for such purposes the making distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

X.

The corporation is not organized for and shall not be operated for pecuniary gain or profit. No part of the property of the corporation and no part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any director or other private individual. The corporation shall never be authorized

to engage in any other activity except in furtherance of the purposes stated above for which the corporation is organized. The corporation shall never engage in propaganda, attempt to influence legislation, participate in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office nor shall any part of its property or any part of the income therefrom be devoted to such purposes.

XI.

In the event of the dissolution of this corporation, to the extent allowed under applicable law, all of the assets of the corporation shall be distributed to, or its assets shall be sold and the proceeds distributed to, another organization organized and operating for the same purposes for which this corporation is organized and operating, or to one or more corporations, funds, or foundations organized and operating exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational purposes which shall be selected by the Board of Directors of the corporation. In the event that for any reason, upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors of the corporation shall fail to act in the manner herein provided within a reasonable time, a senior judge of the Circuit Court of Palm Beach County, Florida shall make such distribution as herein provided upon the application of one or more persons having a real interest in the corporation or its assets.
