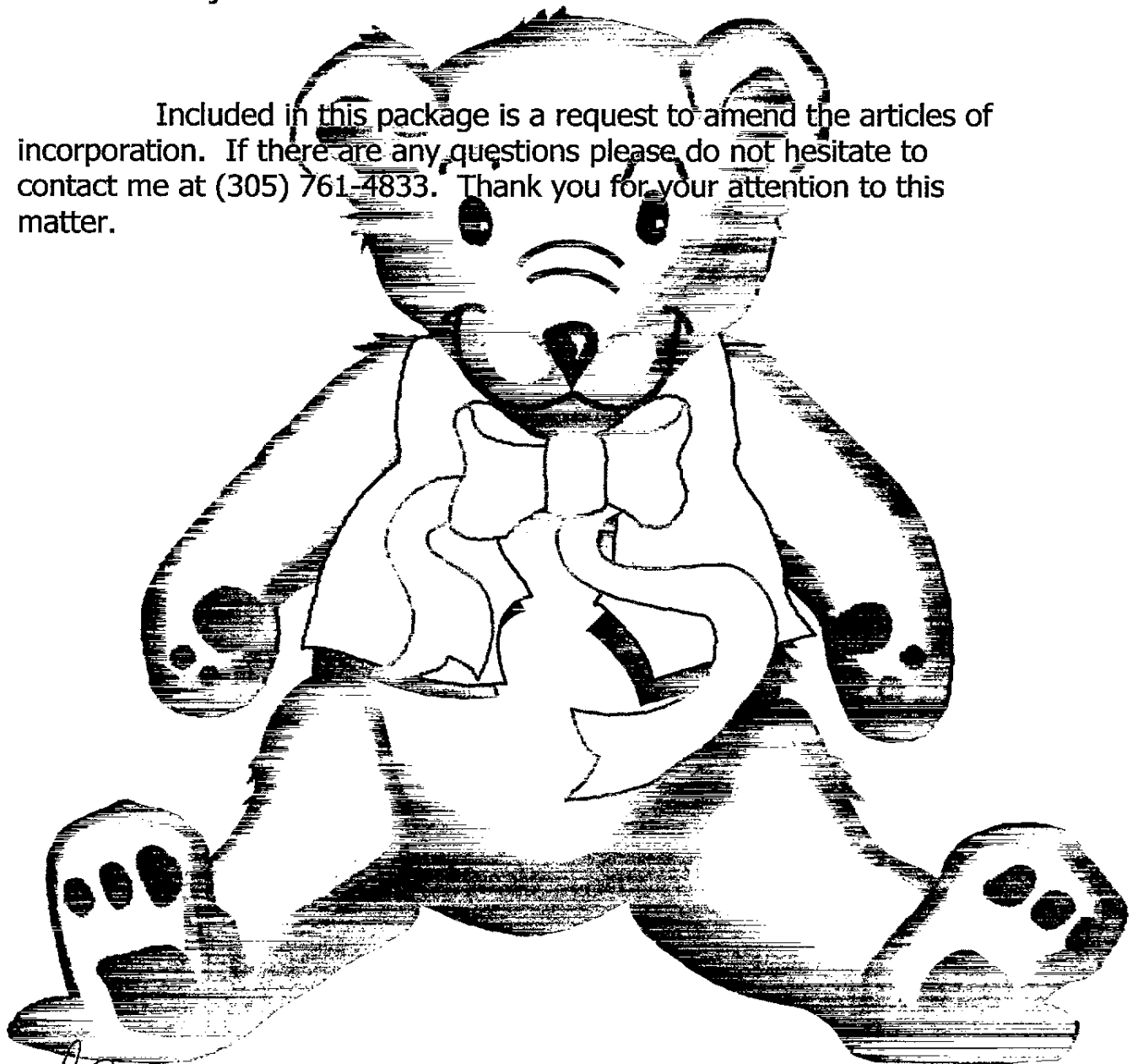

### **AMEND ARTICLE III:**

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

For Kids, By Kids will provide activities addressing a wide range of critical and recognized problems among underprivileged youth and young adults by offering specific remedial and social service programs for the benefit of the underprivileged population and surrounding communities. For Kids, By Kids is geared towards enhancing the lives of today's youth by providing opportunities for them to participate in various programs including, but not limited to, Social Action, Leadership Development, Academic Enrichment, and the support of positive community based activities.

- A. Our Social Action Program is a community-based program aimed at helping young men and women cope with the stress of peer pressure, academic demands, conflict resolution, and family tensions. Participants learn how to develop acceptable behaviors and improve their social skills.
- B. For Kids, By Kids' Leadership Development Program is dedicated to preparing urban youth to become global citizens and community leaders. This program empowers young people to become active participants in the democratic process and realize the power of young people to change their community and world.
- C. The Academic Enrichment Program serves as an aide to the school system by providing students with special tutoring with a variety of academic subjects. This program will also create an opportunity for students, who otherwise would not have one, to develop and enhance their computer skills and technological skills.
- D. For Kids, By Kids will also support other community-based programs by supplying neighborhoods with facilities in which these programs can be held or renovating current facilities. For Kids, By Kids will also support underprivileged communities to improve the appearance of the neighborhood and encourage our youth to participate in such positive activities in the efforts to stimulate pride on one's community.

Schools use interactive, cooperative learning techniques in the classroom to increase student knowledge and skills. For Kids, By Kids through the implementation of the above mentioned programs would achieve the same goals after school. We pride ourselves on being able to positively impact the lives of our struggling youth, both financially and emotionally regardless of race or gender.

In addition, it should be noted that the organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and/or scientific purpose under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
